Job Description

Join our organization in losco County! Pegasus Springs Therapeutic Riding Center (Pegasus Springs TRC) is a growing, federally registered 501(c)3 non-profit adaptive riding center offering Equine Assisted Services. We are seeking an ambitious and reliable part-time stable/barn hand for morning chores 5-6 days each week.

We are a faith-based agency, located in National City, MI and offer programming for children and adults with cognitive, emotional and physical disabilities in a nine (9) county area. Pegasus Springs TRC is the only full-service adaptive riding center in North East Michigan.

The qualifications listed below represent the minimum skills and experience levels associated with performing the duties and responsibilities contained in this job description. The qualifications should not be viewed as expressing absolute employment or promotional standards, but as general guidelines to be considered along with other job-related selection or promotional criteria. This list is not inclusive of the total scope of job functions to be performed.

Duties

This year-round position includes the thorough cleaning of organic matter from horse stalls, runs, dry lot and arena/aisle, adding bedding in season, dumping and adding fresh water in all stall buckets/troughs, filling hay bags for evening feed. Some horse grooming may be needed. Applicant may also be actively involved in training new volunteers who will help on a minimal basis, or afternoons/evenings. Additional duties may be added where agreed upon.

Requirements

Applicant must be a team player, possess a compassionate spirit, be organized, have strong communication and interpersonal skills, and a non-smoker. Knowledge of, or experience working with persons with disabilities is preferred. Other job duties may become available and result in additional hours. Must have your own transportation, stay on task, pass a background check and sign a Code of Conduct agreement. Must arrive at set morning hours, usually determined by length of day and lesson schedules, and also weather determinant.

The ideal candidate will exhibit exceptional professionalism, adhere to dress codes, have a positive attitude, and flexibility to assist other employees as needed. Pegasus Springs is an inclusive center. Applicant has the opportunity to be involved with fundraising and community events. Must be professional around staff, volunteers and clients/client families, and collaborate with other staff and volunteers when required. This is a negotiable part-time hourly position, offering between 12-16 hours per week or more, in a 5-6 day, Monday through Saturday schedule.
