

Job Opening: Behavioral Health Therapist (Part-time Contractor)

Job Description

Pegasus Springs Behavioral Health, a program of Pegasus Springs, in our 9th year is a growing, federally registered 501(c)3 non-profit #82-4572383 offering traditional counseling in a non-traditional setting serving U.S. Military Veterans. We are seeking experienced, compassionate, licensed part-time therapists for our increasing VA client referrals. Seeking experienced LMSW, MA, MS and LPC working part time 5-8 hours per day, 2-3 days per week working with Veteran clients. Knowledge of Equine Therapy is a plus but not necessary. Veteran applicants given priority for this position.. We are a faith-based agency, located in National City, MI and offer *exclusive* behavioral health services to Military Veterans as a Veterans Administration Community Care Network provider serving a nine county area with referrals directly through the VA.

The qualifications listed below represent the minimum skills and experience levels associated with performing the duties and responsibilities contained in this job description. The qualifications should not be viewed as expressing absolute employment or promotional standards, but as general guidelines to be considered along with other job-related selection or promotional criteria. This list is not inclusive of the total scope of job functions to be performed.

Duties

This permanent part time contract position includes seeing between four and six Veteran clients per day for up to three days per week. May include some telephone and telehealth consultations in-office or as a remote position. Must have trauma-informed care experience with addressing PTSD and issues pertaining to military culture, including military sexual abuse and trauma, as well as assisting those transitioning from military to civilian life.

Essential to the position, we require professional ethics while abiding by HIPAA policy, to clinically assess and provide on-going treatment to clients by creating individualized strategies and intervention plans to help clients manage or reduce the impact of depression, anxiety, or cognitive and physical disabilities, guiding clients through their treatment and analyze results to adjust strategies as needed. You may be required to provide support during a crisis and consult with family members to create a comprehensive treatment approach. Individual counseling services will be provided to assist clients in achieving more effective personal and social vocational development. Must be able to conduct traditional and non-traditional modalities of therapy, while focusing on goals set by the client by enhancing their emotional and spiritual needs. Must keep timely, detailed documentation on client progress via Simple Practice (paid for by PSBH) which includes a mobile app to maintain scheduling ease. Must be able to professionally communicate with clients, office staff and other therapists involved in session (Equine Specialist). Additional duties may integrate unmounted (no riding) use of our horses, and nature on our trails.

Requirements

Applicant will possess a Masters in Social Work (LMSW), Masters in Psychology (MA), Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC), with at least five years of experience in a clinical/behavioral health setting. Skills include strong observational abilities, interviewing skills, knowledge of psychological theory, and the ability to build rapport with clients. Knowledge of specific methodologies, such as Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) is accepted. Experience working with Veterans is a plus. Current certification in First Aid/CPR is required. Job may require working around horses utilized in sessions. Must have knowledge of horse behavior relating to the client. Pay is calculated at 50% of the current Michigan Medicare rate for all CPT codes covered by Optum Insurance. This is a part-time contracted position, with 5 to 24 hours (or more) weekly, year-round. Pegasus Springs provides limited liability insurance while conducting sessions on property. Applicant must have professional liability/malpractice insurance. No Medical benefits are offered. Most holidays are observed.
